CARITAS Update – Chatt Torralba

CARITAS Shanghai would like to thank all SHJ parishioners who have so generously donated to help fund Chatt's future medical treatments and living expenses back in the Philippines, as well as to pay off the debt incurred from earlier treatments for her breast cancer. To-date, we have raised just over half of the projected RMB140,000 costs. This includes an impressive RMB17,000 raised from the bake sale last weekend!

Chatt is slowly feeling the positive effects of the Radiotherapy and Bone Anti-Resorptive Therapy, and is now able to walk short distances by herself, slowly and with less pain. She returned to the Philippines on 2 June, where she will stay with family and continue treatment at Paranaque Doctor's Hospital.

CARITAS Shanghai continues to work with the Emmaus and International Parish communities to reach a target of RMB140,000. Your generous financial support and continued prayers are much appreciated.
