The POPE'S MESSAGE TO FATHERS

Teach your children well, always be by their side.

On March 19, the feast of St. Joseph, patron saint of the universal church and Jesus' earthly father, Pope Francis urged all dads in the world to stick by their children's side, teaching them, guiding them and loving them. "I ask that you have the grace to be very close to your children, letting them grow, but being by their side. They need you, your presence, to be there, your love!" the pope told fathers

present in St. Peter's Square.

Despite a massive citywide transport strike in Rome, more than 80,000 people made their way to the square for the pope's weekly audience March 19.

The pope dedicated his catechesis to the role and example of St. Joseph. March 19 also marks the celebration of Father's Day in Italy, as well as the first anniversary of the formal inauguration of Pope Francis' ministry as bishop of Rome and pope.

St. Joseph's "great mission is to be a guardian," the pope said. The saint is a model for all educators, whether they are teachers, catechists, parents, religious or priests, "who are fathers, too, you know!" he said.

Like an educator, St. Joseph guided and accompanied Jesus so he could grow in "wisdom and age and grace," Pope Francis said. This is the same thing all parents must do, and "it would be a serious mistake to think that a father and a mother can't do anything to teach their children to grow in God's grace," he said.

Even though God was Jesus father, St. Joseph lovingly took on the paternal role and taught

ENROLLMENT IS OPEN FOR 2018-19 RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Online enrollment is now open for families who wish to enroll their children in next year's Religious Education program. Use either the QR code or visit the online enrollment form at <http://cn.mikecrm.com/Q3Ms98t>.

Classes offered include:

CHILDREN'S LITURGY

- Is offered during mass for children ages 4-7
- During the Liturgy of the Word, students are accompanied to a classroom, where they hear the Gospel at their level and are led through a discussion and art activity.

FIRST COMMUNION classes

- Are offered 90 minutes before mass on Saturdays and 90 minutes before mass on Sundays
- Some sections are available on weekdays, depending on teacher availability
- As class sizes are limited, students whose parents are willing to teach receive priority enrollment
- Students must be 7 years old by October 1, and only 3 absences are permitted while enrolled in this year-long program.

CATECHISM classes

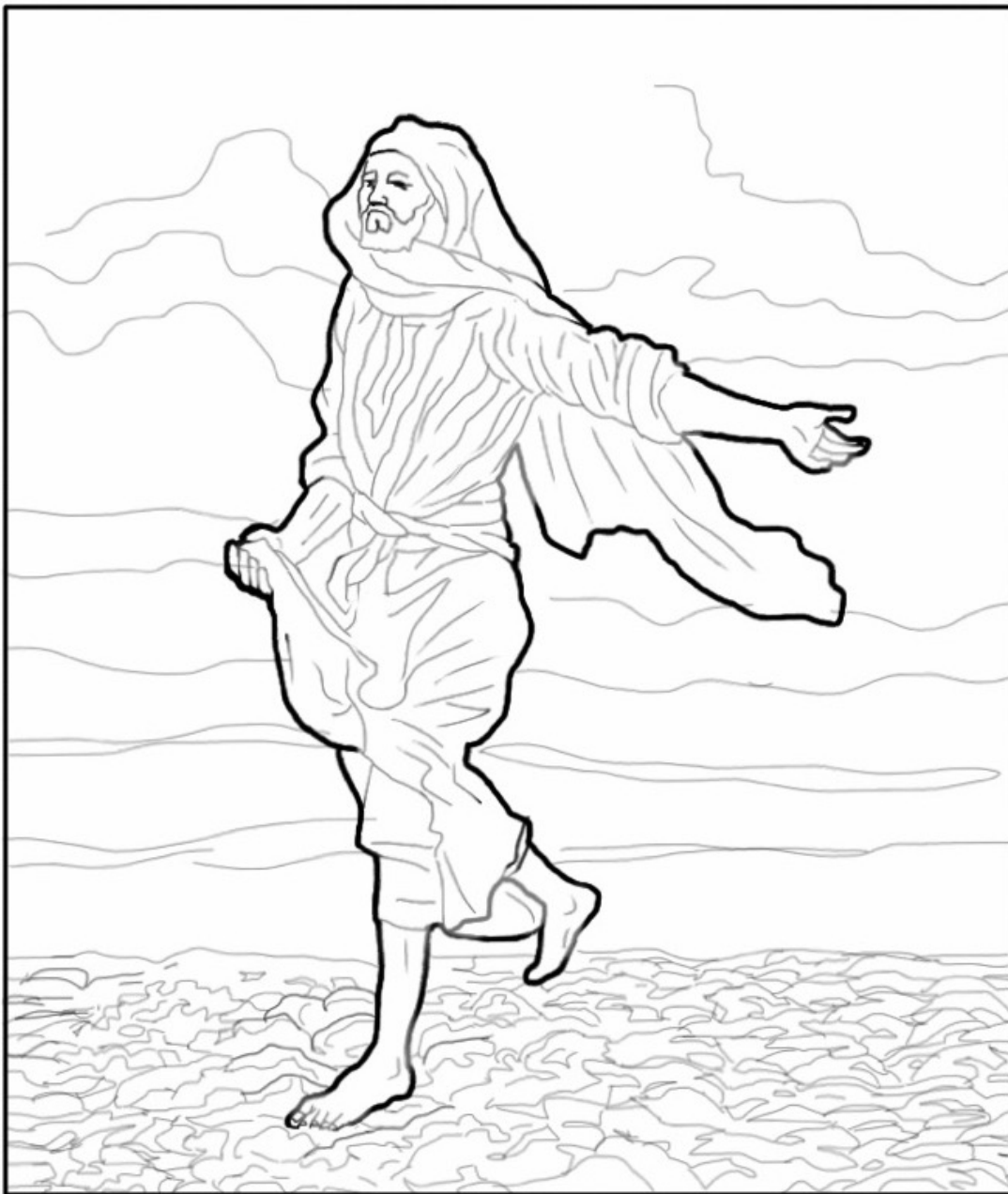
- Are offered 90 minutes before mass on Saturdays and 90 minutes before mass on Sundays
- Using the "Christ Our Life" curriculum published by Loyola Press, students read bible stories, engage in activities and are led through discussions to learn the commandments, Christian values and the Catechism of the Catholic Church.
